Camper Site Regulations

Check-In and Ticket Registration for the Camper Area

Upon arrival, please report to the reception, which is clearly indicated. Show your camper ticket to receive a rearview mirror hanger and a registration form. Fill out both. Attach the rearview mirror hanger to the camper's rearview mirror or place it visibly behind the windshield and submit the registration form at the reception.

A member of the camper team will guide you to your camper spot. Follow the instructions of our team.

For safety reasons, all vehicles must be parked in the same direction, meaning on the grass with the front of the camper facing the street. Please, no discussions about this. These are regulations imposed by the authorities solely for our own safety. Thank you for your understanding.

Camper Area Opening Hours

The camper area is open from Wednesday, April 23, 2025, from 12:00 PM to Sunday, April 27, 2025, 6:00 PM.

Reception

The reception is open during arrival and departure times. Outside of these times, the reception is reachable by phone. The phone numbers can be found on a board at the reception.

Arrival Times

Wednesday, April 23, 2025, between 12:00 PM – 5:00 PM

Thursday, April 24, 2025, between 2:00 PM – 5:00 PM

Friday, April 25, 2025, between 3:00 PM – 7:00 PM

Outside of these times, the camper area is closed. You cannot register!

During the main event on Saturday, April 26, 2025, from 9:30 AM – 5:00 PM, it is not possible to arrive. If you are coming only for the main event, please park in the available day camper spots. You can find the day camper spots on the event cache page. Note that these are limited.

Departure Times

Saturday, April 26, 2025, from 4:00 PM.

Sunday, April 27, 2025, from 9:00 AM.

Outside of these times, you cannot leave the camper area.

Fire Safety in the Camper Area

The camper area is divided into zones, separated by fire lanes. These safety zones are six meters wide. Campers may only be set up in designated spots. Emergency routes must remain accessible at all times.

Items placed in these safety zones may be removed by members of the camper team.

Do's and Don'ts in the Camper Area

- Fire can pose a safety risk, especially with so many people around. Open fires (campfires, torches, candles, grills/BBQs using charcoal) are strictly prohibited in the camper spots.
- Gas BBQs are allowed.
- For your own interest and that of other camper guests, please ensure a quiet night from 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM.
- Generators are not allowed.
- It is not allowed to pitch tents by the camper/caravan.
- Pets must be on a leash. Dogs are not allowed to be walked in the camper area.
- All wastewater tanks must remain closed. It is strictly forbidden to empty them in the camper area. This also applies to chemical toilets. Anyone who violates this rule will be immediately removed from the camper area and denied further access.

Don't Give Thieves a Chance!

Do not leave valuables unattended in your camper. The landowner, camper team, organization team, and local authorities are not liable for theft during the entire event week.

Sanitary Facilities and Waste

The toilets in the camper area are open 24 hours a day throughout the event week. You are responsible for keeping these toilets clean. It is not allowed to empty chemical toilets here!

There will be several waste containers placed in the camper area. Please dispose of your waste in these containers. Keep the camper area clean!

The organization team cannot be held liable for damage, loss, or theft of your property (camper and/or other material items) in the camper area and the event area.

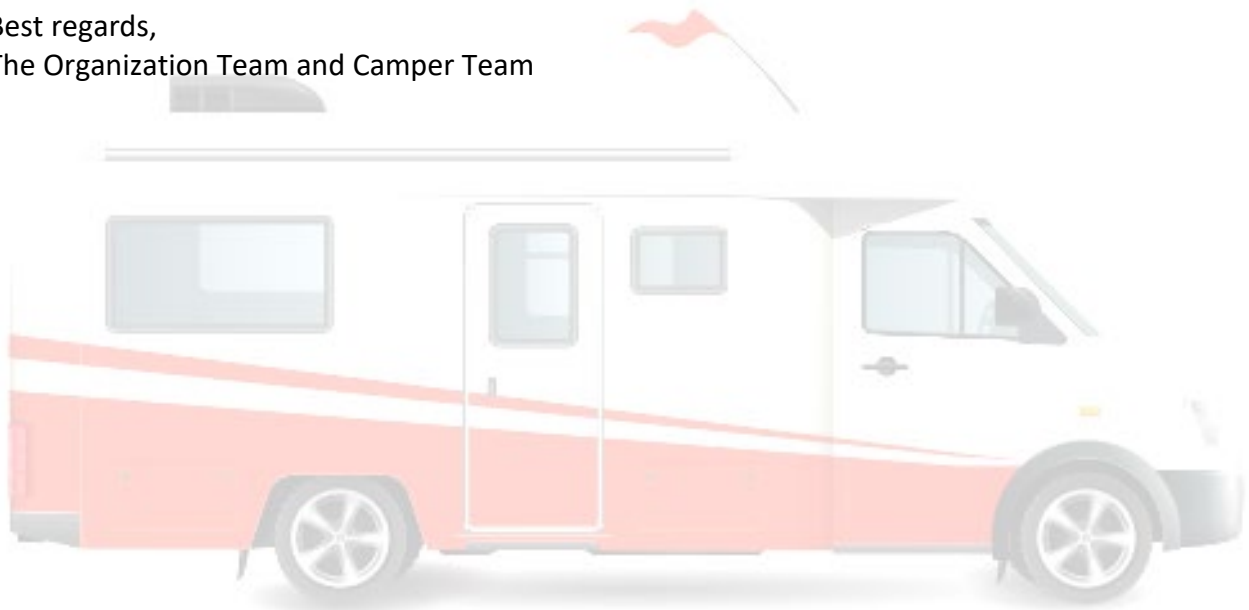
The landowner, camper team, organization team, and local authorities cannot be held liable for personal injury.
